Whakatane High School's Uniform Policy

If a student wears an item of uniform that is non regulation, two things will happen:

- 1. The student will be asked to see Ms. Hughes and she will swap the non regulation item for the day. The student will return the WHS item to her at 3pm that day to get their item back. If the student takes the WHS item home, it must be returned the following day. If it is not returned, an account will be sent home to cover the cost of the item.
- 2. The student will be asked to remove the non regulation item and give it to a teacher. The item can be collected at 3pm on Friday. The parent/caregiver may be asked to come into the school to collect the non regulation item.
