



Are you applying as an **OUT-OF-ZONE** Year 9 student in 2022?

The board has determined that **50 places** are likely to be available for out-of-zone Year 9 students in 2022. The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone. If the school wanted to increase the number of out-of-zone places available, this would need to be published in the local paper.

The deadline for receipt of applications for out-of-zone places is **28 October 2021**. Parents of students who live within the home zone should also apply by this date to assist the school to plan appropriately for next year.

To be considered for an out-of-zone place in 2022, you must have enrolled AND had an enrolment interview by 28 October 2021.

the 4-step process

1

Receive all applications and hold interviews **by 28 October**

2

Out-of-zone ballot held 29 October 2021.

Places are allocated in priority order. Each priority is allocated individually. If there are more applications in a priority than places available, that whole priority is numbered and balloted. *Eg. If 45 places were allocated to priority 1-4 applicants, and there were more than five priority 5 applications, all priority 5 applicants would be balloted, followed by priority 6.*

Once 50 out-of-zone places are allocated, the remaining applications continue to be drawn (in priority order) and become the waitlist.

4

All successful enrolments are contacted within 3 school days and have 14 days to accept or decline the place. In the event of a decline or no response in that time, that place is offered to the next person on the waitlist.

The ballot is held in the presence of a lawyer and verified.
